# ROYAL MILITARY COLLEGE OF CANADA Regular Office Training Plan (ROTP)

Under the ROTP, young Canadians can obtain both an officer's commission in the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) and an undergraduate degree. The Department of National Defence pays for tuition, uniforms, books, instruments, etc. Officer Cadets are paid a monthly salary, undergo military training, and if required, second language training during summer months; full medical and dental care at no cost. Annual vacation with full pay. Upon successful completion of the ROTP, Officer Cadets are awarded a university degree, receive their commission, and become officers in the CAF. Normally, graduates are obliged to serve for a minimum of five years in the CAF; most pilots are required to serve seven years after graduation. Deadline: JAN 31. Depending on availability and screening requirements, applications submitted after this date may still be considered.
